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### Case scenario

A 48-year-old male came in OPD with complain of pain and numbness in right eye. Mass was protruding out completely obliterating the right eye-ball. It was hard tender with irregular margins accompanied with purulent discharge suggesting superimposed bacterial infection. According to the

patient it was a small conjunctival cyst which progressed gradually over a period of 1 year. MRI brain was performed which showed 2 cm confined lesion in superomedial aspect of right orbit. Histopathology revealed well differentiated invasive lesion with clear margins. Picture of right eye lesion is attached below.
